Granddaughter Judy

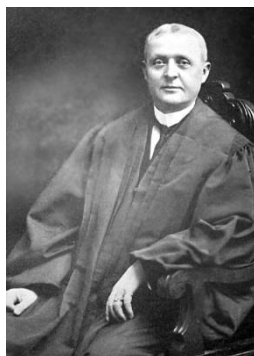
Lawrence shared he was always impeccably dressed and had a pocket watch on a gold chain.

Jean's mother.

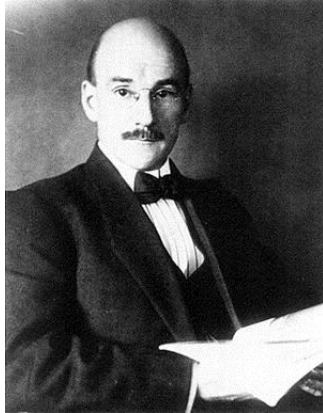
Died at the age of 29 of alcoholic meningitis after being admitted to a sanitarium

DR. HENRY H. GODDARD

(1866-1957)

Alienist (psychiatrist) for the defense.

He wrote "The Criminal Imbecile: An Analysis of Three Remarkable Murder Cases" where he referred to the Gianini murder – a quote from the book "For the first time in history, psychological tests of intelligence have been admitted into court and the mentality of the accused established on the basis of these facts."..."It establishes a new standard in criminal procedure."... "It recognizes that weakness of mind, as an excuse for a crime, is of the same importance as disease of mind." He introduced the term "moron" for clinical use.



DR. CHARLES G. WAGNER

(b. ca. 1857- ?)

Physician for the prosecution.

Superintendent of Binghamton State Hospital (for the insane)
